Yesterday, Year 4 visited The National Justice Museum in Nottingham. Following on from their Spring Term topic about crime and punishment, the children got to experience a Victorian CSI (where they had to solve a murder mystery) and had a chance to explore some of the dungeons where prisoners would have been kept hundreds of years ago. There was also a courtroom activity where Robin Hood was put on trial. Witnesses for both the prosecution and defence were called, and after some deliberation the jury reached a verdict of not guilty!
