Back in February Abigail underwent heart surgery and spent some time recovering at Glenfield Hospital in Leicester. During her time there, Abigail and her family were supported by the charity Heart Link.

Heart Link are one of the charities that raise funds to purchase state of the art equipment for Ward 30 (children's Cardiac Ward) and the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit at Glenfield Hospital.

The funds also go towards providing goodie bags, including a 'Walter Bear', Heart Link's mascot, for each child who stays on Ward 30. The funding has also enabled parents who are staying with their child, to have access to a kitchen to make food for themselves and also to free cups of tea/coffee.

On Wednesday 3rd July, as a way of raising money for Heart Link, we have decided to have a 'Red Day'. We are asking the children to come to school in uniform but to show their support by wearing a red accessory. This could be a red ribbon, hat or red socks. It would be lovely if all the children could bring a donation towards the Heart Link's Charity. Abigail will be sharing her story in assembly with the children next week.
