

What's been happening in school: Anti-Bullying Week

This week, we held our Anti-Bullying week and the children and adults have been learning about how change starts with us. On Monday, the Take Care of Ourselves and Each other reps launched the week with a special assembly. During the assembly, the reps shared some playtime posters which they had created for their Year Group. These posters are just one of the ways in which Team Ernehale can show that change starts with us. All the posters are now on display in each classroom.



Throughout the week, each class has been thinking about the effects of bullying and using various texts to help them with their learning. The Year 3 children have written a problem page letter about being bullied whereas the children in Year 4 wrote a letter of forgiveness to someone who had used a mean word against them. Year 5 focused on the effects of social bullying and produced a diary entry to reflect how the person being bullied was feeling. Children in Year 6 devised an empowerment toolkit to help them identify actions to take if bullying took place.

Team Ernehale have also taken it upon themselves to carry out some random acts of kindness to each other. These included looking after children who were feeling sad, letting someone go before you in the dinner line or paying a compliment to someone. To finish off our week, each Year Group shared some of the work they'd completed about bullying at our Friday Assembly.
