Safety Online

You may be aware that TikTok is becoming a very popular app amongst our children. We thought you might find the following information useful to help support you when it comes to managing your child's use of TikTok.

What is TikTok?

TikTok is a social media platform that lets you create, share and discover 60 second videos. Children can connect with their friends and admirers through likes, comments, and even duets. TikTok videos are creative and fun, however there are reports of online predators targeting users.

If your account is public, anyone can see your videos, send you direct messages, and use your location to find you. Many videos include swearing, people wearing revealing clothing and dancing suggestively and are not age-appropriate for younger children. Users can earn reward points and redeem them for coupons from Sephora and Uber etc. There have been reports of children becoming 'addicted' to the prospect of becoming TikTok famous and doing things they wouldn't normally do to get a larger audience. They may also become obsessed with 'likes' and virtual approval.

How to change the Privacy Settings:

To make an account private, go to the profile page, select the three-dot icon in the top-right corner. Select Privacy and Safety. Toggle the switch for "Private Account." You can also select who can send comments, direct messages, and do a duet. Using the "Friends" setting or turning those features off completely limits contact with strangers.

We would like to inform parents that TikTok requires users to be at least 13 years old.
